Thulhaadhoo in Baa Atoll, just 30 minutes from Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu, is famed for the lacquer work skills of its residents. These artisans are preserving a craft brought to the Maldives in the 17th Century. The pots, vases, ornaments and boxes are exquisite examples of indigenous artistry. Watching the makers work their creative magic is a fascinating insight into ancient craftsmanship. As you tour the island, taking in the many shops and mosques, you are bound to see locals preparing and cooking classic Maldivian delicacies. Essentially, taking a trip to Thulhaadhoo will give you the chance to see how locals genuinely live.
